3 **SEC. 201. EXTENSION AND BENEFIT PHASEOUT RULE FOR**
4 **PANDEMIC UNEMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2102(c) of the CARES
6 Act (15 U.S.C. 9021(c)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1)—

8 (A) by striking “paragraph (2)” and in-
9 serting “paragraphs (2) and (3)”; and

10 (B) in subparagraph (A)(ii), by striking
11 “December 31, 2020” and inserting “March
12 14, 2021”; and

13 (2) by redesignating paragraph (3) as para-
14 graph (4); and

15 (3) by inserting after paragraph (2) the fol-
16 lowing:

17 “(3) TRANSITION RULE FOR INDIVIDUALS RE-
18 MAINING ENTITLED TO PANDEMIC UNEMPLOYMENT
19 ASSISTANCE AS OF MARCH 14, 2021.—

20 “(A) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subpara-
21 graph (B), in the case of any individual who, as
22 of the date specified in paragraph (1)(A)(ii), is
23 receiving pandemic unemployment assistance
24 but has not yet exhausted all rights to such as-
