4 (B) ELIGIBILITY FOR EXTENDED COM-
5 PENSATION.—Section 2107(a) of the CARES
6 Act (15 U.S.C. 9025(a)) is amended by adding
7 at the end the following:

8 “(8) SPECIAL RULE FOR EXTENDED COM-
9 PENSATION.—At the option of a State, for any
10 weeks of unemployment beginning after the date of
11 the enactment of this paragraph and before April
12 12, 2021, an individual’s eligibility period (as de-
13 scribed in section 203(c) of the Federal-State Ex-
14 tended Unemployment Compensation Act of 1970
15 (26 U.S.C. 3304 note)) shall, for purposes of any
16 determination of eligibility for extended compensa-
17 tion under the State law of such State, be consid-
18 ered to include any week which begins—

19 “(A) after the date as of which such indi-
20 vidual exhausts all rights to pandemic emer-
21 gency unemployment compensation; and

22 “(B) during an extended benefit period
23 that began on or before the date described in
24 subparagraph (A).”.

25 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—
