6                   “(B)       TERMINATION.—Notwithstanding  
7           any other provision of this subsection, no pan-  
8           demic unemployment assistance shall be payable  
9           for any week beginning after April 5, 2021.”.

10       (b) INCREASE IN NUMBER OF WEEKS.—Section  
11   2102(c)(2) of the CARES Act (15 U.S.C. 9021(c)(2)) is  
12   amended—

13           (1) by striking “39 weeks” and inserting “50  
14   weeks”; and

15           (2) by striking “39-week period” and inserting  
16   “50-week period”.

17       (c) APPEALS.—

18           (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 2102(c) of the  
19   CARES Act (15 U.S.C. 9021(c)), as amended by  
20   subsections (a) and (b), is amended by adding at the  
21   end the following:

22                   “(5) APPEALS BY AN INDIVIDUAL.—

23                           “(A) IN GENERAL.—An individual may ap-  
24           peal any determination or redetermination re-  
25           garding the rights to pandemic unemployment
